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LEONARD WERNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

In memory of Leonard Werner, NAFA's Past Chairman and Founder, NAFA makes available each year individual university or college entrance scholarships. Because of the large number of excellent applications we receive each year, beginning in 2005 the scholarship program was revised to provide ten scholarships of \$1,000 U.S. each. This will ensure that a greater number of deserving applicants have an opportunity to receive financial assistance. The details of the scholarship program are set out below.

ELIGIBILITY

The student receiving the scholarship must be the legal child, grandchild or spouse of a NAFA consignor customer who is resident in North America; or the legal child, grandchild or spouse of a full-time employee of NAFA.

QUALIFYING INSTITUTION

The applicant must be entering the first year of a minimum four-year degree-granting program from an officially recognized university or college in North America.

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING APPLICANTS

1. Academic achievement
2. Extracurricular activity involvement in leadership capacity
3. Community service involvement
4. Work experience
5. Essay describing personal goals and aspirations

DATE OF GRANTING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The ten scholarships will be granted and paid August 31 each year based on academic terms beginning in the August/September time period.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

All applications must be received by June 30 for the August/September academic year.

SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Recipients will be selected by a panel comprised of representatives from the Werner family and representatives from the NAFA Board of Directors.

Any decisions made by the panel will be in its sole discretion based on an evaluation of the information submitted by each applicant on the application form, which is attached. Decisions will not be subject to appeal.
