## Wild Fur Continues to Struggle

Today's Wild Fur sale consisted only of previously lotted and unsold goods. All fresh Wild Fur receipts will be offered in our major April auction. Only the Coyote, Musquash and Can-Am Sable offering consisted of fresh goods.

A collection of Western Lynx Cat sold 30%, with support from Italy and Greece. Larger sizes and better colors sold under good competition and had the highest clearances, while flatter sections were mainly unsold.

Red Fox sold 100% overall, under good competition, although at lower levels. The strongest demand was for heavier types used for trim.

Raccoon continues to struggle to find acceptable market levels and were mostly withdrawn.

A small collection of commercial Beaver sold 31%.
