NAFA'S WILD FUR PROMOTIONS PAYING OFF STRONG WILD FUR OPENING

One of the largest buyer attendances for Wild Fur saw NAFA's May Wild Fur collection start with 100% clearances at sharply advancing prices. We are very pleased to see that, as the largest handler of Wild Fur in the world, NAFA's international promotion of Wild Fur has resulted in this renewed interest from all major markets. Obviously our Northern Lights campaign in China and other countries has created new opportunities for manufacturers and retailers alike.

The sale began with Sables, which advanced 40% over recent levels, with strong competition from all major markets. Heavy trimming goods advanced the most.

Fishers advanced 30%, selling 100%, again with all major markets participating. Otters found renewed interest from the Asian markets which resulted in prices advancing 35%. Remainder of the Wild Fur will be reported tomorrow, June 1st.
